

Statement of Faith

We believe that all Scriptures (both Old and New Testament) are divinely inspired and preserved by God therefore; they represent the final and supreme authority in all matters of faith and life.

We believe in one true and only living God – The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the Creator of Heaven and Earth.

We believe in the triune nature of this God- God the everlasting Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

We believe that Jesus Christ is the unique Son of God in the sense that He is eternal, pre-existent and only begotten in the way he was begotten through virgin birth. He was born without sin; led sinless life, was crucified, buried, and after three days, he rose bodily from the dead never to die again in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven was glorified, and is coming back.

We believe that man in his natural state is a sinner, lost, undone, without hope and without God. Because of man's inherent rebellion toward God, he is condemned already. He cannot justify himself and thus can not save himself from wrath to come. He needs a Savior.

We believe that the atonement for all mankind was provided through the shed blood of Jesus Christ. It is only through His blood and only on the cross. He is the sacrificial Passover lamb who takes away the sin of the world. He is the long awaited Messiah of Israel and the Savior of both Jews and Gentiles.

We believe that the terms of salvation are, repentance of sin before God, and a personal heart felt faith in the Lord Jesus Christ which results in the regeneration of the person- the new birth. Salvation comes by grace through faith not of works so that no man should boast.

We believe the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity whose purpose in the redemption of man is to convict man of sin, regenerate the penitent believer, guide the believer into all truth, indwell, fill and give gifts to a believer that they minister the Gospel as Christ would to man.

We believe the Scriptures clearly set forth the doctrine of eternal punishment for the lost and eternal bliss for the saved – hell for the unsaved and heaven for the saved.
